- **Check the switch (electric models)!** Make sure the switch is in the _____ position before plugging it in.
- **Stay healthy.** It's a good idea to wear a _____ while sanding. Always sand in a well ventilated area, and if your sander is equipped with a dust bag, make sure it works correctly.
- **Don't force it.** Don't use too much _____ when using a finish sander. Light pressure works best. Pushing too hard creates unnecessary stress on the sander and can damage your work.
- **Use a mat.** When using a _____, secure your work to a bench, or use a "non-slip" type mat.
- **Stop it!** Make sure the sander has come to a _____ before setting it down.
- **Get a GRIT!** Correct sanding starts with _____ grit (80-120) and goes to progressively _____ grits (150-220). _____ a grit takes longer to smooth a surface, wastes sandpaper and, leaves you with a poor looking project.
