

- Unplug it! Always unplug the cord when making or changing the blade.
- Hold or clamp all work securely! The portable jig saw only cuts on the ______ of the blade. If your work is not firmly clamped or held, it will jump and cause possible injury to you and the saw.
- **Too small?** Do not attempt to cut small pieces that can't be clamped or held ______.
- Wait to remove. Make sure the blade has stopped completely before ______ it from the cut.
- Check it! Some portable jig saws have a trigger lock. Always check to make sure the trigger is before plugging the saw in.
- Use the correct blade for each job. _____ teeth = wood cutting blade; _____ teeth = metal cutting blade.
- Cord saver. Keep the cord out of the of the saw.
