



- **Is guard in place?** Make sure the \_\_\_\_\_ is in place and operational. If it's not, do not use the miter saw.
- **Keep fingers a minimum** of 6" away from the blade at all times. Keep your hands out of the blade \_\_\_\_\_ at all times.
- **Cross-cut only!** The power miter saw is used to cross-cut wood \_\_\_\_\_.
- **Full speed.** Allow the motor to reach full speed before cutting. \_\_\_\_\_ the motor or partial stalling can cause major tool damage.
- **Wait until the saw** blade comes to a \_\_\_\_\_ before clearing away scraps. Clear scraps away from saw blade after each cut.
- **Support long pieces** of \_\_\_\_\_ with an outboard tool rest.
- **Check in back.** Make sure no one is standing directly behind the saw before you begin your cut. Small pieces can be \_\_\_\_\_ out the back of the saw.
- **Never perform any** \_\_\_\_\_ **operation** with the power miter saw.
- **Is bed locked?** Before cutting make sure bed is tight, and in the \_\_\_\_\_ position.
